Dr. Daniel J. Rejman Elected to the Board of Directors of The American Board of Orthodontics

The American Association of Orthodontists (AAO) House of Delegates on May 20 elected **Daniel J. Rejman, D.D.S., M.S.**, of Castle Rock, Colo., as a director of the American Board of Orthodontics (ABO). The House of Delegates convened in conjunction with the 2022 AAO Annual Session in Miami Beach, Fla.

Each ABO director represents one of the eight constituent organizations of the AAO and serves an eight-year term, which culminates in the position of president. The ABO directors are responsible for establishing policy with regard to the board certification of specialists in orthodontics. Dr. Rejman, who represents the Rocky Mountain Society of Orthodontists (RMSO), will become president of the ABO in the 2029-2030 year.



The ABO is partnered with the AAO and is recognized by the National Commission on Recognition of Dental Specialties and Certifying Boards as the national certifying board for orthodontics and dentofacial orthopedics. Board certification is a process by which an individual orthodontist is voluntarily examined by his or her peers regarding orthodontic knowledge and clinical skills. The successful completion of the ABO examination process is a demonstration to the dental profession and the general public of the orthodontist's pursuit of continued proficiency and excellence in orthodontics.

Dr. Rejman is the owner and orthodontist of Meadows Orthodontics, a two-location practice in Castle Rock, Colo. Prior to starting Meadows Orthodontics in 2013, he was an associate orthodontist with practices in Aurora, Colo., and Annapolis, Md. Dr. Rejman earned his master's degree in orthodontics from Marquette University in Milwaukee, Wis., in 2007 and his dental degree from the University of Michigan in 2003. His undergraduate degree is from Hobart College in Geneva, N.Y.

Dr. Rejman attained ABO certification in 2007. A member of the College of Diplomates of the ABO (CDABO), Dr. Rejman has served as its president for the 2021-2022 year. He has been a member of the CDABO Council representing the Rocky Mountain Society of Orthodontists and Southwestern Society of Orthodontists regions since 2014. He has served as an instructor for the CDABO Preparatory Course for the ABO examination since 2015.

His other professional memberships include the American Association of Orthodontists, the American Dental Association, the Colorado Dental Association, the Rocky Mountain Dental Association and Omicron Kappa Upsilon, the national dental honor society.

In the community, he is a member of the Castle Rock Chamber of Commerce and was named its Citizen of the Year in 2021. He has been listed by *5280* magazine as a Denver-area top orthodontist since 2012, and has been recognized as “best orthodontist in Castle Rock” by the *Castle Rock News-Press* and *Douglas County Living* magazine since 2014.

On being elected to the ABO board, Dr. Rejman said, “I am excited and honored to be selected as a director for the American Board of Orthodontics. I hope to bring energy and passion to add to the ABO’s long history of promoting the highest standards of care for our profession, and for our patients.”
